Spotify is trying to be more transparent about what it pays artists on its platf orm with a new website called Loud and Clear.

This data is kind of meaningless without context, and one thing that the company doesn't share is how many artists are on its platform. In a 2020 report, Ro lling Stone claimed that Spotify said it had three million creators on its platf orm in 2018. Since then, Spotify has shared that 60,000 new songs are uploaded to Spotify every day, suggesting that there are likely many more than three milli on creators on the platform.

While the numbers don't exactly paint a picture of many people living happil y off of their Spotify streams alone, many artists make revenue off more than on e streaming service, plus live shows (in a non-COVID-19 world). ans that every month, Spotify takes every song and calculates how much it was st reamed compared to the total streams in that song's local market. That means if a song is streamed one time for every 1,000 streams in Canada, the artist would, theoretically, get \$1 per stream. In practice, this doesn't o ften work out this cleanly since there are thousands of artists all competing fo r the most streams in each market, and the rights to each song are owned by record companies, aggregators and other third-party intermediaries that operate betw een Spotify and the artists.
